### Treatment Methods

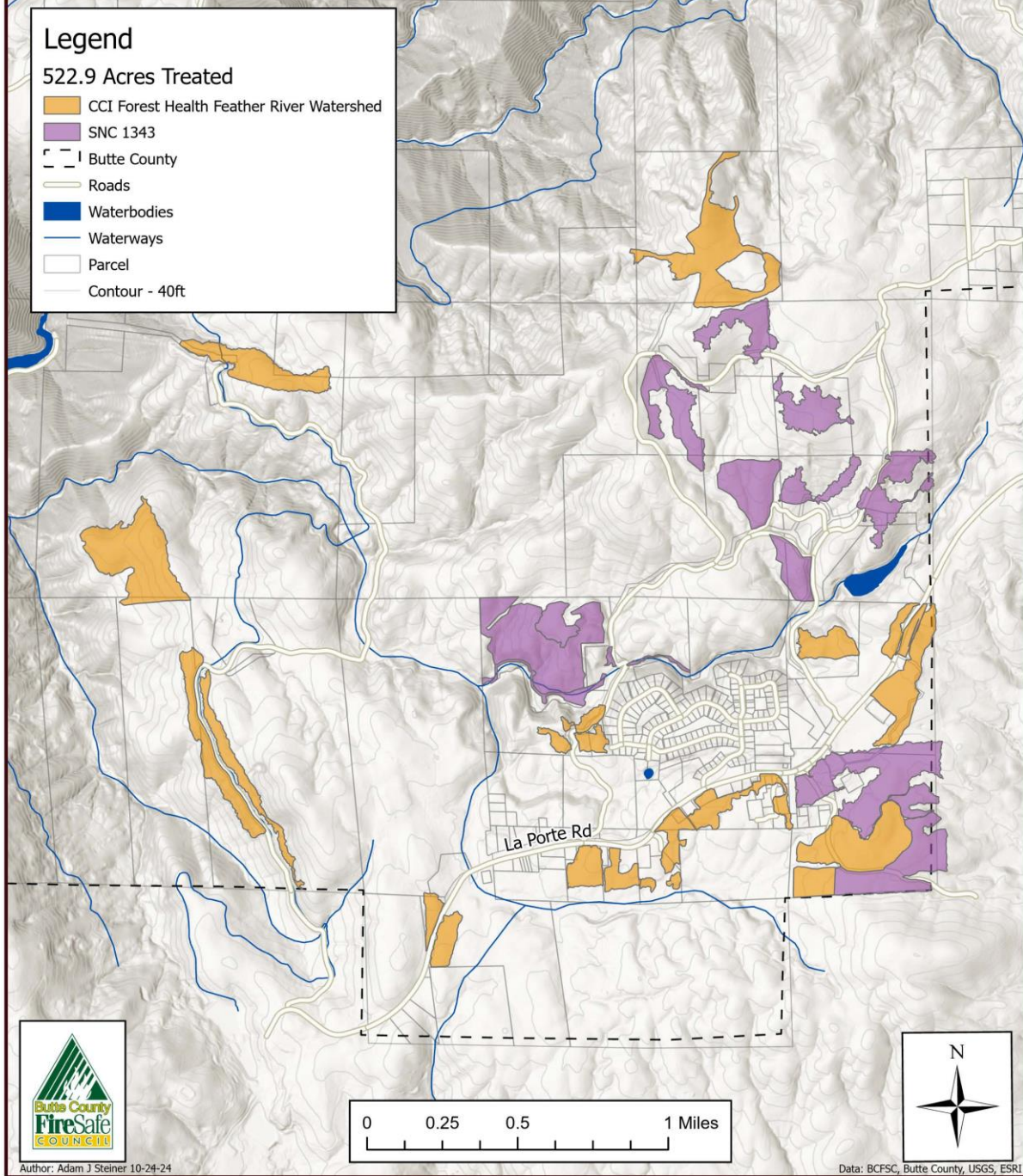
- Mastication
