

## Tree Removal Program Available in Paradise

Preparations are being made to continue a tree removal program aimed at removing dead and dying hazardous trees that could impact new construction or standing homes. Many residents within Paradise face issues regarding hazardous trees inhibiting rebuilding or threatening life in standing homes.

Three generous community organizations are supporting the effort:

- 1. The Paradise Rotary Foundation has awarded the Butte County Fire Safe Council, a local non-profit organization, a \$200,000 grant.
- 2. The North Valley Community Foundation-Butte Strong Fund awarded a \$50,000 grant.
- 3. Golden Valley Bank Community Foundation awarded \$50,000.
