




Village Parkway Fact Sheet- 7/19/23



Project Description: A strategic fuels reduction and hazard tree removal project off Village Parkway in the community of Paradise.

Project Goals:

- Reduce the impact of a wildfire to the surrounding communities.
- Improve the probability that fires developing around Village Parkway can be contained in the initial attack phase.
- Provide safer egress for residents' evacuation and ingress for fire personnel in a significant fire event.

"Our vision is to create communities within a landscape that are resistant to the devastating impacts of wildland fires."

Project Timeline:
May 2023 – June 2023

Treatment Method:
Hazard tree removal
Removal of 200+ dead/dying hazard trees.

Mastication
Mastication of brush and dead/dying trees 10" and under.

Outcomes:
Mastication Acres = 30 Acres
Trees Removed = 200+
Landowner Participants = 2




