Background:

The Valley Creek Botanical Special Interest Area (SIA) is the largest intact remnant of old-growth Sierra mixed-conifer forest in the Northern Sierra Nevada.

The area around LaPorte is part of a number of recent forest restoration projects. As part of a larger Sierra Nevada Conservancy watershed protection project, there are 20 acres in need of replanting.

“Day of” Details: Tree seedlings, gloves, and reforestation tools will be provided. Please wear closed-toed shoes, and please also come prepared with food and water for the day (light refreshments will be provided).

Volunteers will be given custom “Adopt-a-Forest” t-shirts the day of the event.
