### No-Cost Chipper Program for Wildfire Safety! 7-7-2021

Do you have overgrown brush and other vegetation that needs Chipping? The Chipper Program is available through summer months offering no-cost service to residents who are working on their wildfire safety clearance. The program provides an alternative to burning or hauling fire hazardous brush. Requests can be made by calling 530-877-0984 or on the website [www.buttefiresafe.net](http://www.buttefiresafe.net).

To prepare brush and limbs for the Chipper Program:

1. Stack cut brush and limbs in a row within 5 feet of the road edge with the ends facing towards the road.
2. Rows should be stacked no more that 4 feet high.
3. Keep mud, rocks, and roots out of the rows.
4. Locate the rows so the truck and chipper can easily access them, no off-road locations allowed.
