Chipper Program for Wildfire Safety Ongoing Availability September 9, 2021

The Chipper Program is offering service to Butte County Residents who are working on their wildfire safety clearance, through the end of 2021.

The program provides an alternative to burning or hauling fire hazardous brush.

How to prepare brush and limbs for the Chipper Program:

- Stack cut brush and limbs in a row within 5 feet of the road's edge, with the cut ends facing toward the road.
- Rows should be stacked no more than 4 feet high.
- Branches should be no more than 8 inches in diameter and no more than 10 feet in length.
- Keep mud, rocks, poison oak and roots out of the rows
- Locate the rows so the truck and chipper can easily access them; no off-road locations allowed.
