

No-Cost Chipper Service For Fire Hazard Reduction

1. To request Chipper Program service you can go online to **ButteFireSafe.net** or call our office at **530-877-0984**.
2. The Chipper Program typically operates from the end of fire season through the spring, dependent on funding. Check our website to find out if the program is available.
3. How to stack rows for the Chipper Program:
 - ⇒ Stack cut brush and limbs in a row within five feet of the road or driveway edge. Stack with the ends facing toward the road or driveway.
 - ⇒ Rows should be stacked no more than four feet high.
 - ⇒ Keep poison oak, mud, rocks, roots and rootballs out of the rows.
 - ⇒ Locate the rows so the truck and chipper can easily access them; no off-road locations allowed. Rows should look like the photo at right.
4. Please note that the chipped material cannot be hauled away. It will either be piled or broadcast back into the area where it was chipped based on your preference.
5. The Chipper Program does not provide chipping for orchard material or timber harvest material.
6. Limbs up to eight inches in diameter and not more than 10 feet in length may be chipped.



Cut ends must face the same direction, pointing toward the driveway or road that the chipper will use to access the piles.
