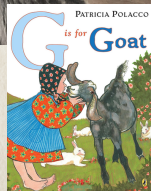
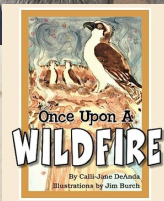
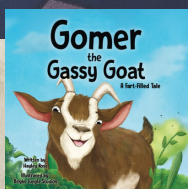
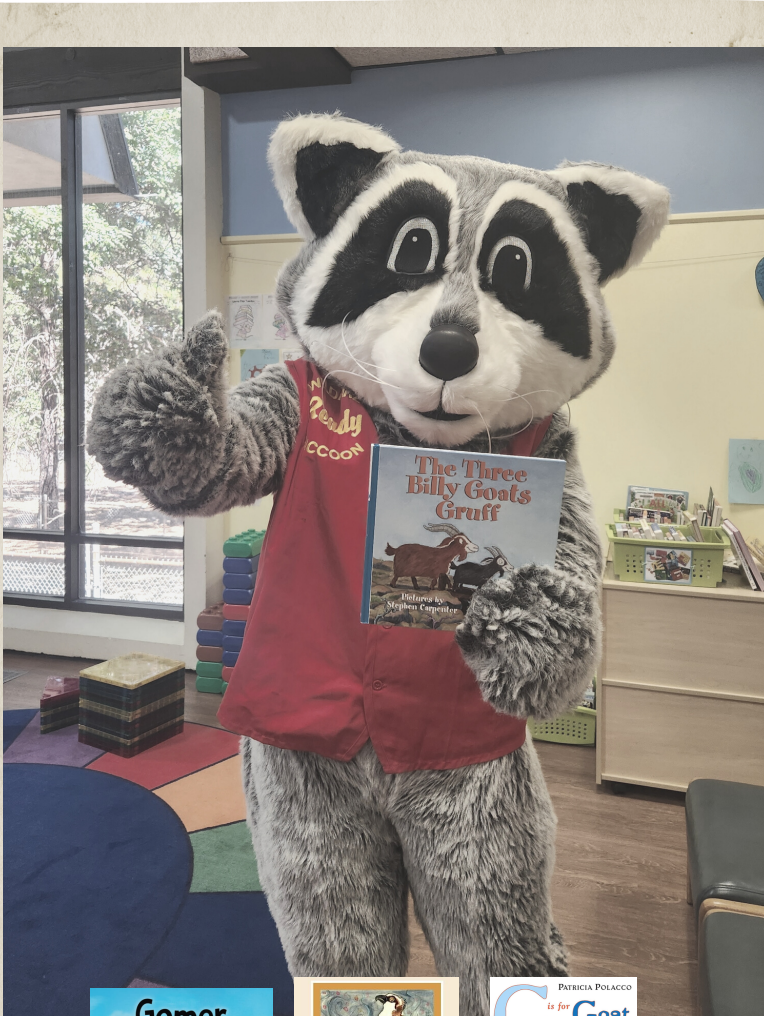
Ready at the Library
