Project Description

This project is in the foothills within the community of Magalia, CA. Several fuel reduction projects will occur over the next year as part of Phase 1 to ensure a more resilient forest and protect the community from high severity wildfires.

Project Objectives

1. Thin overstocked stands, canopy cover remaining at 70%.
2. Strengthen fuel breaks around the community for greater fire safety.
3. Improve health of the forest and watersheds, enhancing the ecology of the local wildlife.
4. Reduce risk of catastrophic wildfire.

Total Planned Project Acres Phase 1 = 155.8

Hand Cut & Chip: 43.5 acres

Hand Cut & Pile: 5.1 acres

Hand Cut & Pile Burn: 7.7 acres

Mastication: 99.5 acres
